

In this usage guideline, we will be explaining how you can Simple Job Board Add-on for the Divi theme builder to design the awesome Job Listing and Job Details page.


How to use the SJB Listing Module

Step 1: Plugin Installation


Download and install the Simple Job Board add-on for Divi theme Builder on your website

Step 2: Add Jobs

Before using the Job Board Add-on for Divi Builder, please select the Job Pages Layout as SJB Layout from the Simple Job Board Settings->Appearance. Don't forget to press the save button.




Insert the job into Simple Job Board from Dashboard of the WordPress.




Step 3: Use of Listing module

Search “**sjb**” and then click on the SJB “**Listing module**”.




After adding the widget, you can style the listing module and hit the save button.



How to use the SJB “Details Module”


Step 1: Go to Divi theme builder

Go to Divi theme builder and create a template with the instance “All Jobs”



Step 2: Create a Template body


Click on add custom body and then select **“Build Custom Body”**.




